



**The School Rules are simple and ensure a good time is enjoyed by every pupil attending School Disco. There are plenty of ways to get admitted to School Disco, but only a few things that will get you expelled:**

- Drunkenness, rowdiness and rudeness in the queues or at School Disco. If you show up to School Disco drunk, you will be expelled...even if you have purchased a ticket ahead of time.
- Non-adherence to the mandatory dress code. **Make sure you have a full school uniform or you will be denied entry.** Below are our uniform requirements.
- Pupils under the age of 18 for regular entry and under the age of 21 for Queue Jump & Private Bar entry. Your current photo ID will be checked. We can only accept a current photo passport or current Photocard ID Drivers License. These are the only two forms of ID that the Police allow security to check and verify age. No photocopies are accepted. Genuine article only.
- Please be aware that we reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone.

#### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

- School characters such as netball teams, cricketers, headmasters, caretakers are o.k.
- Fishnets are optional – not compulsory!!
